**Fees and Charges 2010**

| <b>Membership</b>   |               |                   |   |
|---------------------|---------------|-------------------|---|
| Entrance Fee        | £30.00        | Once only payment | The Entrance Fee is paid by Full and Family Members on joining the Club including transfer from Introductory Crew Member.   |
| Full                | £150.00       | Annual            | A Full Member is a person who, at the date of election, is eighteen years of age or over.   |
| Family              | £165.00       | Annual            | A Family Member is a Full Member and Family Membership shall include his or her spouse and all their children under the age of sixteen years.   |
| Joint WBA           | £135.00       | Annual            | A Joint Member is a Full Member who having been a Full Member of both the Club and the Wear Boating Association ("WBA") for not less than two years has an application to the Club and the WBA for Joint Membership accepted by both the Club and the WBA.  |
| Joint WBA Family    | £150.00       | Annual            | A Joint Member is a Family Member who having been a Family Member of both the Club and the Wear Boating Association ("WBA") for not less than two years has an application to the Club and the WBA for Joint Membership accepted by both the Club and the WBA.  |
| Life                | =£750 or £825 | One off payment   | A Life Member is a Full or Family Member who having been a Full or Family Member for not less than five years and who having attained the age of sixty five has made a single payment of five times the current Full or Family Membership subscription.   |
| Introductory Crew   | £75.00        | 1st year only     | An Introductory Crew Member is a person of eighteen years of age or over, who has not previously been a member of the Club other than as a Social Member and who does not own a boat. Such membership is only available for a period not exceeding twelve months ending 31 <sup>st</sup> December in the year of election. An Introductory Crew Member shall pay to the Club a subscription of 50% of the prevailing Full Membership subscription. Membership will transfer automatically to Full or Family membership after the 1st year of Introductory Crew membership. If an Introductory Crew Member becomes a boat owner, they shall immediately be liable to pay the Entrance Fee and apply for transfer to Full or Family Membership. |
| Country             | £15.00        | Annual            | A Country Member is a person who having been a member has moved to a residence beyond a one hundred mile radius of Sunderland and whose transfer to Country Membership has been approved by the Committee   |
| Junior              | £20.00        | Annual            | A Junior Member is a person who, at the date of election, is under the age of eighteen years.   |
| Social              | £40.00        | Annual            | A Social Member is a person of eighteen years or over at the date of election.  |
| Introductory Social | £20.00        | 1st year only     | A Social Member is a person of eighteen years or over at the date of election. Such membership is only available for a period not exceeding twelve months ending 31st December in the year of election.   |
| Student             | £30.00        | Annual            | A Student Member is a person of eighteen years or over but under the age of twenty-five years who is following a full-time course of education.   |

| Cruiser Winter Storage             | £70.00  | Annual   | Winter Storage from Lift-out to Lift-in. (October to April)<br>Note: Fees for winter & summer long term storage shall rise as shown below:<br>1st consecutive winter & summer at normal rates<br>2nd consecutive winter & summer at normal rates<br>3rd consecutive winter or summer at double normal rates<br>4th consecutive winter or summer at treble normal rates<br>etc |
| Cruiser Summer Storage             | £140.00 | Annual   | Summer Storage from Lift-in to Lift-out (April to October)<br>Note: Fees for winter & summer long term storage shall rise as shown below:<br>1st consecutive winter & summer at normal rates<br>2nd consecutive winter & summer at normal rates<br>3rd consecutive winter or summer at double normal rates<br>4th consecutive winter or summer at treble normal rates<br>etc  |
| Short term Cruiser Storage         | £23.00  | per week | 1st two weeks no charge, then £20/week until the total fee is reached   |
| Cruiser Trailer and Cradle Storage | £65.00  | Annual   | Annual storage charge for trailers and cradles where cruiser winter or summer storage has not been paid for during the previous year.   |
| Crane                              | £50.00  | Annual   | Annual charge for use of the Club Crane by Cruisers.<br>There is no charge for people using the crane for lifting of tenders to gain access to their boats.<br>All crane users must be trained.   |
| Crane Casual Lift by members       | £40.00  | per lift | Adhoc Cruiser lifts by members who have not paid the annual fee.  |
| Crane Casual Lift by non-members   | £80.00  | per lift | Use of the crane by non-members   |

| <b>Mooring Charges</b> |                   |                 |   |

| Back Trot              | £105.00           | Annual          | Covers the use of the mooring from Lift-in to Lift-out. All Club Moorings are vacated during the winter.                  |
| Mid Trot               | £125.00           | Annual          | Ditto   |
| Front Trot             | £140.00           | Annual          | Ditto   |
| Outer Trot             | £150.00           | Annual          | Ditto   |
| West Trot              | £150.00           | Annual          | Ditto   |
| Club Lift-in Lift-out  | Approx £100.00    | per lift        | Charges based on the cost of craneage divided by the number of boats lifting.   |
| Club Mast Lift         | Approx £25.00     | per mast lifted | Charges based on the cost of craneage divided by the number of masts lifting.   |
| Cruiser Harbour Dues   | Circa £100 - £170 | Annual          | Applicable to non-dinghies. Fee set by the Port of Sunderland Authority and collected by the Club. Varies with boat size. |

| Club room booking (Night time/no catering)                               | £80.00 | per event       | Night Time booking from 6.00pm (Function for a non-member)<br>Bookings after 11.00 pm will be charged a supplement of £20  |
